- 3 For areas outside the Cattle Tick Infected Area (Kimberley). Mandatory quarantine on presence of disease. Discretionary quarantine on suspicion of disease.
- 4 Diseases not foreign to Australia. Discretionary quarantine on presence of disease.
- * Diseases included in the national notifiable disease list but are not regulated under the *Exotic Diseases of Animals Act 1998* or the *Stock Diseases (Regulations) Act 1968*.
