Nursery stock:

S-NU Nurseries, plants and flowers

Treatment and cleaning of potential carriers:

S-C1 Cleaning of trucks, large machinery and containers
S-C2 Cleaning of vehicles (up to six-person)
S-C3 Cleaning of small items (for example, tyres, engines and parts, animal cages and garden tools)
S-FM Fumigation
S-GD General disinfection (other than fumigation)

Handling of potential carriers for experimental or laboratory purposes:

S-LA Laboratories

Approved places:

S-AP-LS Storage and inspection of livestock
S-AP-C2 Cleaning of used vehicles

Responsibilities of registered premises

The business identifies quarantine risk material, isolates those goods by placing them in the designated Quarantine Area and contacts Quarantine WA for inspection. The goods remain in the Quarantine Area until cleared by the Quarantine WA inspector. The business is responsible for maintaining the Quarantine Area and for the security of goods being held for inspection.

Quarantine Registered Premises



QUARANTINE WA

Under the Western Australian *Plant Diseases Act 1914*, a Registered Premises is a business which has entered into a Registered Premises Arrangement with Quarantine WA.

The purpose is to share the responsibility of protecting Western Australian industries and the environment from the importation of exotic pests and diseases which are present elsewhere in Australia but have not become established in this State.

Registered Premises Arrangements enable businesses to receive and unload interstate goods under Quarantine WA procedures. The business assumes responsibility for identifying, isolating and declaring quarantine risk material, which is then held in a designated Quarantine Area for clearance by Quarantine WA inspectors.

Quarantine WA ensures the arrangement continues to work effectively through a regular audit program.

Benefits for your company

A business that enters a Registered Premises Arrangement enjoys greater flexibility, better time management and increased efficiency because it can eliminate unnecessary delays in the delivery of goods and services.

Without a Registered Premises Arrangement, goods placed under quarantine at border checkpoints may be directed to non-registered premises and, if the container is sealed, it may not be unloaded until a Quarantine WA inspector is present. This can result in non-risk goods also being held, leading to delays in delivering those goods to clients.

By entering a Registered Premises Arrangement, however, a company can unload the container, place quarantine risk material in its designated Quarantine Area and deliver all non-risk goods to clients promptly.

Categories of arrangement

To become a Registered Premises, a company must demonstrate that it can comply with certain criteria, which are dependant on the category of the registration. Sixteen categories of Registered Premises Arrangement are available, and a company can register under multiple categories. The categories are as follows.

Storage and inspection of imported potential carriers:

S-FV	Fruit and vegetables
S-GF	General freight including produce, plants and flowers
S-HS	Hides and skins
S-WL	Wool
S-PE	Personal effects
S-SE	Seed
S-VM	Vehicles and machinery (small)
