

Queensland fruit fly (Qfly) eradication program

## Is a green waste collection happening in your street?



You are in a Qfly Quarantine Area

This means there are restrictions in place relating to green waste left out for verge collection.

Queensland fruit fly (Qfly) has been detected in your area and a Quarantine Area (QA) has been declared. Home-grown Qfly host fruit\* cannot be moved out of this area and must be disposed of.

## **Residents located in the QA must:**

- REMOVE ALL QFLY HOST FRUIT\* whether ripe or unripe - from branches before leaving them out for verge collection.
- TREAT the Qfly host fruit\* removed from green
  waste by immediately eating or treating (cooking,
  freezing for a minimum of 24 hours, or solarising
  by securing fruit in a sealed, heavy-duty black
  plastic bag and placing in direct sunlight on a hard
  surface for seven days minimum).
- DISPOSE of treated Qfly host fruit\* in your general waste bins (not green waste bins).



<sup>\*</sup> Qfly host fruit includes some fruiting vegetables. A full list is in the Quarantine Area Notice on the DPIRD website.
