

CSS Quarantine Area Notice Flowchart

This flow chart is intended to support stakeholders in meeting the management requirements outlined in the QAN. It should be read in conjunction with the Guidance Document. It should also be read in conjunction with, but subject to, the QAN. If there any inconsistencies between this flow chart and the QAN, then the QAN will prevail.

Legend

"Clause" - a clause in Schedule 2 of the QAN

"CSS" - Didemnum vexillum (carpet sea squirt)

"DPIRD" - the Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development

"protected waters" - the coastal waters of WA (see Figure 2 of the Guidance Document)

"AMC CUF" - Australian Maritime Complex Common User Facility

"Vessel" - the "Vessel" refers to both the definition within the QAN as well as also referring to the person in control of the vessel when entering or exiting the QA.

NOTE: If the vessel is removed from the water for the purposes of treatment, refer to clause 5

NOTE: Where a biofouling report is to be submitted to DPIRD, a copy must be provided within five business days of the completion of the biofouling inspection.
