# Beef cattle from Queensland to the Kimberley or Pastoral Regions of Western Australia

Biosecurity and Agriculture Management Act 2007 (BAMA) and Regulations 2013

This declaration provides evidence for the exemption of the described beef cattle from pre-entry faecal testing for liver fluke prior to movement from Queensland into the Kimberley Region and Pastoral Regions of Western Australia on the basis that the stock were born and have grazed solely in Queensland, the Northern Territory or the Liver Fluke Test Exempt Area of South Australia, and is to be attached to the form [Health certificate for movement of stock to Western Australia \(Form LB 1\)](#). Note: border treatments may still apply in addition to this declaration.

### Definition

#### The Liver Fluke Test Exempt Area of South Australia means:

That area of South Australia north of Highway 32 from the New South Wales border to Peterborough, Highway 83 from Peterborough to Carrieton, and north of the boundaries of the counties of Dalhousie and Frome from Carrieton to Port Augusta, and those areas of the Eyre Peninsula north of County Flinders.
