



## Notice of Intent (NOI) to import goods into Western Australia

- Goods imported into Western Australia must comply with import requirements under the *Biosecurity and Agriculture Management Act 2007*.
- Commercial carriers must complete and submit this form to Quarantine WA (details below) to provide a minimum of 24 hrs notification of the entry of any declared pest or potential carrier into the state.

Failure to comply with the above requirements may be an offence and penalties may apply.
