



Notice of Intent (NOI) to import subject to import permit

Important: Under the *Biosecurity and Agriculture Management Act 2007* goods imported into Western Australia are subject to quarantine restrictions.

Persons importing an organism or potential carrier in accordance with an import permit must provide a minimum of 24 hrs notice, in an approved manner, of the item and place of entry. In the case of import under permit, the person to whom the permit was issued is considered the importer.

Failure to comply with the above requirements may be an offence and penalties may apply.
